Job Description:

The physical therapist diagnoses and treats individuals of all ages, from pediatrics to geriatrics, who have health-related conditions that limit their ability to move and perform functional activities in their daily lives. The physical therapist examines each individual patient, selects appropriate assessment, and develops a plan using treatment techniques to promote healing, reduce or manage symptoms, promote the ability to move, restore ROM, strength, and function, prevent disability, and improve overall functional mobility. In addition, the physical therapist works with patients to prevent the loss of mobility before it occurs, by developing fitness- and wellness-oriented programs for healthier and more active lifestyles, as well as injury prevention. The physical therapist may provide care for people in a variety of settings, including inpatient hospital (observation, acute care and/or swing bed), outpatient clinic, schools, skilled nursing facilities, home health care, sports and fitness facilities, and work-site settings; as well as provide Home Safety Evaluations for hospital in-patients receiving physical therapy services. The physical therapist is also responsible for obtaining patient information, identifying and documenting criteria in obtaining third party payor coverage, and orienting patients to purpose and procedures of PT interventions. The physical therapist also develops physical therapy schedules, follows ND state regulations for supervision requirements of support personnel (Physical Therapist Assistants, Physical Therapy Students, and Physical Therapy/Rehab Aide), participates in quality management activities, attends weekly interdisciplinary meetings (Care Conference and Discharge Planning), collaborates with staff of other disciplines in regards to patient care, and assures completion of documentation."
