## Hospice/Visiting Nurse Services

### CNA – PRN (as needed)

This rewarding position involves caring for and providing comfort to patients in their home.

The primary functions of a hospice aide are performing various patient care activities and related non-professional services necessary in caring for the personal needs and comfort of patients. The services of a hospice aide are given under the direction and supervision of a Registered Nurse. The CNA works directly with patients, families, co-workers, providers, chaplain, and other staff. Requires the completion of a certified nursing assistant course. Previous nurse aide experience preferred.

80% of the job for home visits requires travel so must have a valid driver's license.

Ability to arrange and rearrange daily schedule, taking into consideration the duration and location of scheduled visits, meetings, unexpected situations, etc. Some time is spent completing and reviewing charts, as well as independent decision-making.
